Re: Mobile Phone Policy

I am writing to inform you of our school mobile phone policy. It has come to our attention that some students have been using their mobile phones during school hours, which is causing disruptions to the learning environment.

As a result, in line with a mobile phone and technology policy regarding the use of mobile phones in school, any student seen using a mobile phone during school hours will have their phone confiscated for 24 hours.

If a student fails to comply with this policy, they will be issued an internal exclusion. Persistent defiance and failure to follow the school mobile phone policy will result in a suspension from our school.

We appreciate your support in enforcing this policy. It is important that the school remains a place for learning, free from distractions.

Mobile phone technology is not needed during the school day and does not form part of your child's curriculum. Once they leave the school premises, they will be allowed to use their phones.

Please remind your child to keep their mobile phone out of sight while on school grounds.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping us maintain a productive learning environment for all students.
